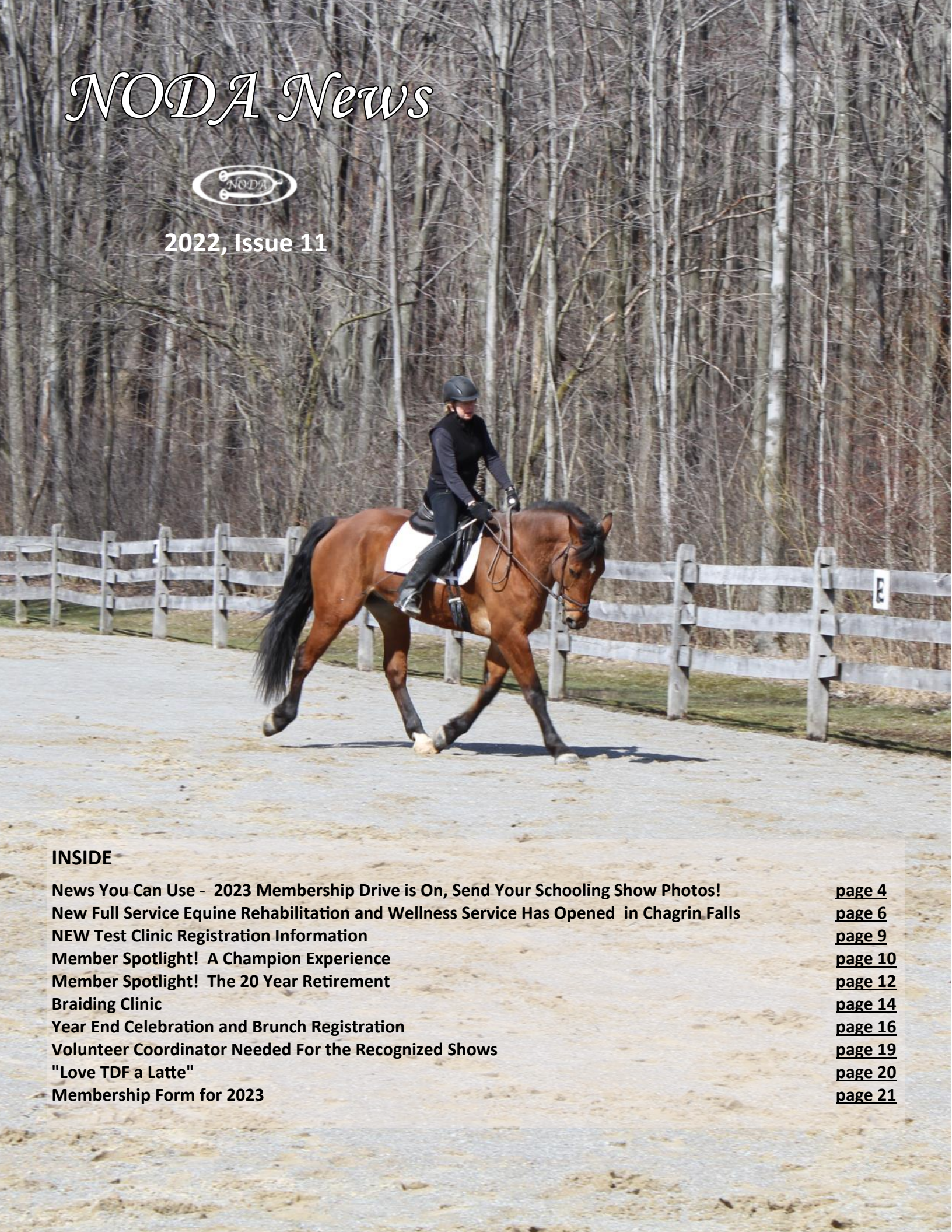

New Full Service Equine Rehabilitation and Wellness Service Has Opened in Chagrin Falls

Meridian Equine Rehabilitation and Wellness, owned by Endia Peckham DVM, is a beautiful new, full service equine rehabilitation facility located at 16930 Snyder Rd. in Chagrin Falls, Ohio just around the corner from Chagrin Valley Farms.

Dr. Peckham has been my horses' veterinarian for a number of years. She is also a certified equine physical therapist and specializes in alternative therapies such as acupuncture and chiropractic adjustments. Recently, she helped me rehab my dressage horse, Tony, after he sustained 2 significant soft tissue injuries - one to his suspensory ligament (in 2021), and another to his superficial digital flexor tendon (in 2022). She treated him on my farm with hot laser therapy following stem cell injection and PRP at Ohio State University for the suspensory ligament injury. She has also treated him with acupuncture in the past for performance issues - with good results.

I visited her new farm facility with Tony for a follow up ultrasound and we treated him to a half hour of vibe plate therapy, which he enjoyed a lot. Maybe it was because of the "all you can eat" hay buffet that was available to him for the half hour he was on it. The effects of the vibe plate are analgesic as well as to improve circulation.

Dr. Peckham felt the time was right for a Rehab and Wellness Center which allows owners to leave their horses with overnight for the time they need so they can receive the

care that is not available to them at home. The closest facilities like Meridian Equine Rehabilitation and Wellness are in Pittsburgh and Columbus. Referrals to the facility have already come from other veterinarians in the area.

Horses board in comfortable airy stalls that are stripped and sanitized after each horse. Each stall has the availability of a walk out paddock if deemed appropriate for the horse. The paddocks are 12 x 60 and can be made smaller is necessary. While staying on the farm, they receive any number of appropriate therapies by Dr. Peckham and her knowledgeable staff.

If a horse needs daily hand walking, that is done by the staff as well. Molly Gamin, a professional trainer, is available to ride them in the indoor arena when the time is right, applying basic dressage principles for strength and flexibility as she follows the prescribed protocol. Molly lives on the farm and helps manage their care with Sharon Sykes, Dr. Peckham's Vet Tech. Two of the five employees are professional riders, one specializes in biomechanics. A physical therapist is also available to work with a rider who is having riding issues.

The advantage of horses being in-house is that Dr. Peckham (pictured left/standing left) with Vet Tech Sharon Sykes are able to observe them on a daily basis and target their re-

hab treatments. The average horse receives 1 ½ to 2 hours of dedicated rehabilitative handling each day. Many owners are not able to devote the time it takes to help their horse's rehab, especially if they are

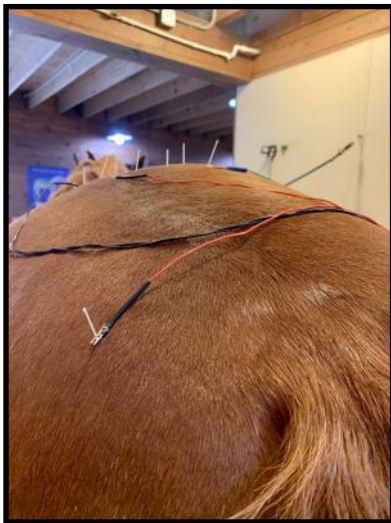

working and may not notice subtle changes that are impeding progress. Owners receive daily texts and sometimes photos or videos of their horse's treatment. A horse can stay for a few days or a few weeks, or even longer. They are discharged when they are sound enough to be ridden and the client is sent home with exercise homework. The average length of stay is 2-4 weeks.

There is also an option for horses to ship in as outpatients and return home after their therapy. This way their owners can observe and ask questions.

The cost to keep a horse there is a bit below the average of what area boarding stables are charging and then treatments are an additional cost.

Plans for the near future include an addition of a new building to house a tread mill, a salt therapy room to treat respiratory and skin issues and a physical therapy room.

Molly, a sensitive and experienced rider also begins the process of bringing horses back into under saddle work under the direction of Dr Peckham.

While Dr. Peckham still makes farm calls, she would like to see a transition to mostly in house treatment in the years to come. Her hope is to bring another veterinarian into her practice as well.

Dr Peckham offers lameness diagnosis, acupuncture, Bemer, chiropractic, Shockwave therapy, Magnawave Therapy Class VI laser therapy, Reiki, Kinseology Taping, Myofacial Release and Cupping, Injury or post-surgical lay-ups, specific rehabilitation treatment programs. Meridian Equine Rehabilitation and Wellness works with other Veterinarian Services and accepts rehabilitation clients and referrals.

Also offered for the rider and sound equine are manual therapies such as dry needling, cupping, deep tissue work, IASTM, myofascial release, exercise prescription, biomechanical assessment.

Coming soon will be a solarium, salt therapy, water treadmill with or without incline, salt water cold spa, Tui-na, and PainTrace.

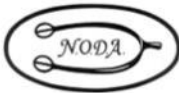

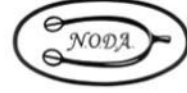

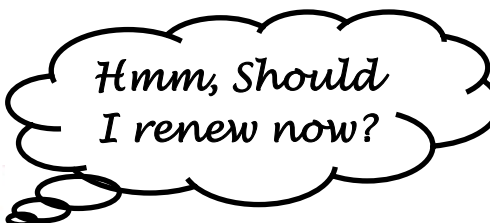
