**Our Vision** The past three years we have had an amazing time at camp bonding, learning and just enjoying being together. We envisioned camp to be just like a summer camp but for us! This camp is designed for us, the adult rider who wants to have fun, learn, and enjoy being together in a laid-back atmosphere. You are free to participate in all or just a few of the activities. Feel free to audit all lessons, trail ride or just hang out and enjoy being in touch with your inner kid! This is OUR time to be at camp!

**Housing** We are encouraging everyone to stay where they are comfortable. Patty and I will stay in cabins at the KOA located close to the farm at 33807 Winona Rd, Salem, OH 44460. <u>NO meals will be provided other than the Friday night pizza party</u>). We will have water, small packaged snacks and carrots in our welcome stall.

**Other Details** Stone Gate Farm requires signed liability waiver that will need to be completed closer to camp. Be aware with changing guidelines the NODA release may be updated and we will need everyone to sign the new one when that happens. We will be in touch via e-mail/private Facebook group to discuss specifics. Final schedule including ride times will be sent to you the week before camp.

- Arrive after 1 pm, check in to stalls unpack and settle in
- Free time to school in rings, trail ride, check out the site, tour the property, get to know the other campers

#### Friday, June 24, 2022 Day 2

- Dressage lessons (30 minute private) all day with Barb Soukup
- Bring your lunch. Casual Lunch chat with Barb questions, topics.
- Dinner/Lecture with judge Robin Birk (Pizza and Salad -- cost included in camp fee)

#### Saturday, June 25, 2022 Day 3

- Dressage lessons (30 minute private) all day with Robin Birk
- Working Equitation Lessons (groups of 2 or 4) all day with Emily Gill

#### Sunday, June 26, 2022 Day 4

- Ride-a-test or a dressage lesson with Danielle Menteer- L\* judge
- Camp Check Out after last ride

\*\*Campers can arrange optional jumping/mountain trail lessons with Laura Kosiorek-Smith / Kyle Smith / Jackie Smith (extra cost for these lessons, not included in the camp fee).
