DEADLINE: Anne L. Barlow Ramsay \$25,000 Grant, August 15, 2022.

The purpose of the Anne L. Barlow Ramsay Grant is to showcase talented American-bred horses ridden by United States citizens by training and competing in Europe or Wellington, Florida. The horse and rider applicants will be competing successfully at Prix St. Georges or higher and demonstrate an ability to move forward into High-Performance competition. A Selection Committee comprised of distinguished, experienced dressage leaders will review the applications, and choose the recipient, subject to the approval of TDF's Board of Directors.

GRANTS

DEADLINE: Team Tate Mentorship and Leadership Fund

Friday, July 15, 2022.

The goal of this Fund is to provide funding for recipients to work with their dressage mentors to improve their equestrian skills and/or to receive business, leadership, or coaching education. These training opportunities should help riders develop skills that will enable them to become more well-rounded and successful professionals.

DEADLINE: Lynn Palm Western Dressage Fund for Individuals,

July 20, 2022.

Grants in the amount of \$1,000 each are available for riders who need financial help to continue their Western Dressage education. Applicants can be professionals, amateurs, or youth. The grant review committee will look for applicants who are eager to grow and improve, have shown a passion for the sport, have financial need, and who have demonstrated a commitment to learning. Grants must be used for Western Dressage educational experiences that are not within the horse and rider's typical training plan. Examples include clinics, camps, more lessons than a rider normally receives, etc.

The TDF is looking for everyone to help them support the dressage community. Beth Baumertt, President suggests three way to help them.

Please identify talent that needs assistance and encourage grant worthy applicants to apply for TDF awards.
