The horse and rider applicants will be competing successfully at Prix St. Georges or higher and demonstrate an ability to move forward into High-Performance competition. A Selection Committee comprised of distinguished, experienced dressage leaders will review the applications, and choose the recipient, subject to the approval of TDF's Board of Directors.

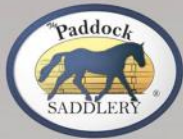
