## USDF FEI Youth Clinic Series

Region 2

The USDF FEI Youth Clinic Series is an educational opportunity for youth riders striving to compete at FEI levels. The goal of this series is to promote hardworking, talented youth riders who want to rise to the top of the discipline. These clinics are taught by top U.S. riders including George Williams, Anne Gribbons, Lilo Fore and Sabine Schut-Kery.

Each clinic includes two days of private lessons, theory sessions, and auditing. Riders must submit an online application and eight riders will be selected to participate. Riders should be 14-21 years of age. Riders ages 12-14 competing in FEI Pony classes may also apply. Consideration will also be given to U25 riders if space allows.

Starting January 1, 2023, all youth and their designated chaperones may audit for free.

Adult USDF members may audit for \$20/per day and adult non-members may audit for \$40/per day. Auditor registration is by walk-in only.

### NODA News Will Go Digital in 2024

As of January 1, 2024 NODA News will be published six times per year (Issue 1 February, Issue 2 April, Issue 3 June, Issue 4 August, Issue 5 October, and Issue 6 December) in digital format.

Two publications per year will also be in grayscale print, Issue 2 April and Issue 6 December.

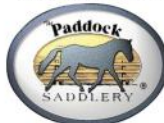

# Reflections on Dressage Adventures and More!

When Patty Keim and I created Dressage Adventures five years ago, it was purely for selfish reasons- we wanted to go to camp together and couldn't find one that checked off all the boxes- so we created one. For four years I loved going away with my horse Sully and bonding, challenging ourselves and just having a great time, while running the program at the same time.

This year circumstances were different- I lost Sully in September- and had a new horse I was excited to bring, except for a pesky impending knee replacement surgery that took riding off the books for this year. I was honestly not sure how much fun I would have at Adventures with no horse to ride and only the "running of the event" to do. I was anxious to see how the weekend would pan out, and I was very pleasantly surprised!

I saw a young horse scared of her shadow learn to try new things and actually relax under saddle due to the gentle ways of her rider and the tidbits of information she got from the instructors. I cheered on a friend who got a beautiful uphill canter de-

part and jumped a small fence in the Working Equitation ring for the first time. I saw someone learn good tricks for canter pirouettes and another rider master walk-trot transitions. And I spent a lot of time taking pictures and videos to document it all for the riders.



Did I miss riding? For sure! But I learned a lot by watching, made new friends, enhanced friendships, had deeper conversations, soaked up sun, enjoyed being outside and was happy to be at the barn. There is nothing like a weekend with devoted horse women- with or without my own horse to ride- that brings out the best in me.

Every year we have had an amazing group of adventurers and this year was no exception. The respect, the support, the laughs, the fun, the learning, the growth, the challenges, the exhaustion all play a part in creating NODA Dressage Adventures and more. Looking forward to 2024!

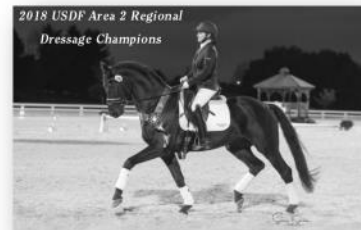
